



Adopt a Resolution to Designate November 19 as Prostate Cancer Awareness Day

On November 19, 2014, the National Assembly of Quebec unanimously adopted a resolution declaring November 19 as "Quebec Prostate Cancer Awareness Day."

This resolution was renewed by the National Assembly in 2025, and several municipalities across Québec have also adopted resolutions specific to their communities.

Our Goal for 2026

We aim to mobilize as many Québec municipalities as possible to adopt a resolution designating November 19 as Prostate Cancer Awareness Day in their respective communities.

Sample Resolution for Municipalities to Adopt:

WHEREAS an average of 8,100 Quebecers are diagnosed with prostate cancer each year and approximately 1,200 men die from the disease annually;

WHEREAS an average of 18 Quebecers are diagnosed with prostate cancer every day;

WHEREAS PROCURE is the only charitable organization in Québec entirely dedicated to the fight against prostate cancer through research, awareness, information and support, and the funds raised are reinvested in Québec;

WHEREAS it is important to raise awareness among the residents of (*your municipality*) about prostate cancer screening;

WHEREAS PROCURE's "Noeudvembre" fundraising campaign provides an opportunity to wear a bow tie throughout the month of November, and especially on November 19;
