

<p>Pad or guard</p>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Very discreet and available in a variety of shapes and sizes ▪ Different levels of absorption available ▪ Ideal for small to moderate leaks ▪ Easily and discreetly fits in a jacket or coat pocket during outings ▪ Adapted to male morphology 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Requires snug-fitting underwear rather than loose boxers ▪ Must be positioned well in the underwear and may shift, potentially causing overflow ▪ Not suitable for significant urinary incontinence ▪ Requires a trash can for disposal ▪ Normally, needs to be changed 3 to 5 times per day
<p>Incontinence briefs</p>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Ideal for heavy leaks ▪ Good absorption ▪ Different sizes according to morphology ▪ Cut and style adapted to male anatomy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Material may make noise when moving ▪ May be visible if wearing loose, thin, light-colored, or low-rise clothing ▪ Needs to be changed during the day depending on soiling ▪ May cause irritation and discomfort during periods of high heat and humidity ▪ Requires a trash can for disposal ▪ Requires a bag or other means to carry replacements if you are on the go

<p>Washable protective briefs</p>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ More comfortable than disposable versions ▪ Various styles available ▪ Different sizes according to morphology ▪ More environmentally friendly compared to disposable protections ▪ More economical than disposable models in the long run 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Higher cost to purchase ▪ Appropriate washing routine necessary (beware of irritating cleaning products) ▪ Limited absorption ▪ May require more frequent changes
<p>Adjustable incontinence briefs with attachments</p>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Brief can be changed while lying down or standing ▪ Adjusts according to morphology for a better fit ▪ A good choice for someone who spends a lot of time sitting or lying down 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ This product model is often not specific to male morphology
<p>Penile clamp</p>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Comfortable when fitted correctly ▪ Easy to use ▪ Non-invasive and discreet ▪ Different sizes according to morphology ▪ Ideal for outdoor outings and sports activities ▪ Reusable 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Wearing duration is limited and should be worn by varying pressure at different points on the penis shaft ▪ Prolonged use may cause irritation or skin lesions ▪ Requires regular cleaning ▪ Some men may find the clamp limits their mobility or comfort ▪ A looser garment is suggested to avoid visibility ▪ Risk of leakage if improperly adjusted ▪ Not ideal for people with blood circulation disorders
<p>Feminine sanitary or incontinence pad</p> 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Not adapted to male morphology ▪ May shift, be ineffective, and uncomfortable
